

Stamford Campus Parking Policy

Location: The UConn-Stamford parking garage is located at [1194 Washington Blvd., Stamford CT 06901](#)

Garage hours: Monday – Friday: 6:30 a.m. - 11:00 p.m.; Saturday: 6:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.; Sundays – the garage is closed. This schedule may vary during holidays. Advance notice will be sent to the campus beforehand.

Authorized users: All students, faculty and staff.

Decals: All students, faculty and staff are required to obtain a parking decal issued by the University of Connecticut.

Students: Each student must have paid their tuition in full to pick up a decal from the Bursar office, room 202. Students must fill out the [Student Vehicle Registration](#) form found on our [website](#) or in the Bursar office. Student decals are valid through August of each year. Also note that parking decals are non-refundable and non-transferrable once purchased. Decals may be obtained a week before classes start and must be properly displayed on the vehicle to avoid being ticketed. Valid decals from other UConn regional campuses will be honored, provided that the individuals comply with this parking policy.

NOTE: Students in the Part-time MBA program can pick their decals up from the MBA office.

Faculty/Staff: Proof of registration is required to pick up a decal. Decals can be obtained from the Welcome Center staff.

Motorcycles: All motorcycles must also have decals. The cost is the same as a vehicle decal (\$40) and motorcycles parked in areas other than a parking space will be ticketed, possibly towed at the owner's expense, or both.

Parking garage rules:

- Only DMV registered vehicles are allowed to park in the UConn garage.
- 1st floor: There are *designated* areas for Faculty, Staff, and Student parking. Handicap parking is available in the designated spaces and must have a valid handicap permit. Faculty and staff designated parking is for faculty and staff only. In addition, there are spots designated for “Future Husky” on the right side as you enter the first floor. These spots are reserved for students and/or parents who are touring the campus or have an appointment with the Admissions office.
- 2nd floor: This area is Student and Visitor parking. All student vehicles must have a decal.
- 3rd floor: Not available for parking to UConn faculty, staff, or students. These spots are leased to local agencies by UConn. Parking is authorized after 5:00 p.m.

Enforcement: Please comply with this policy. University police will patrol and ticket violations on a regular basis. Parking tickets are \$30 and up. To appeal a parking ticket please complete a Parking Appeals form, available at the UConn Police substation (3rd floor of parking garage) or in the Bursar office, room 202.

Parking ticket appeals: To appeal a parking ticket please complete a Parking Appeals form, available at the UConn Police substation (3rd floor of parking garage) or in the Bursar's office, room 202. An appeal committee made up of three UConn-Stamford students, one graduate and two undergraduates, will review appeals on a regular basis or as needed. Their decision is final.

Overnight parking: Leaving your vehicle in the garage overnight is not authorized. Vehicles will be towed that are left overnight without authorization. If you are going on official UConn related business from the campus and returning to the campus, send an e-mail to the Associate Campus Director at jeff.dewitt@uconn.edu to get approval to use the garage. Include the make, model, license plate number/state of your car, and your trip details.
