# F.E.R.P.A.

A federal law, the **Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974** (also know as the Buckley Amendment), as amended, affords students certain rights regarding their educational records.

When a student reaches the age of 18 or begins attending a post-secondary institution, regardless of age, FERPA rights transfer from the parent to the student. The College will obtain an observed signed consent form from the student that authorizes the parent to receive non-directory information and/or attend a meeting regarding the student's academic record.

# F.E.R.P.A. Privacy Waiver

A student can authorize someone to receive non directory information and/or participate in an appointment by completing an **Online FERPA Privacy Waiver**. Please have your student visit: <http://web2.uconn.edu/ferpa/>

The waiver is designed to grant controlled access, via a four digit code, to specific non-directory information with specific offices.

For example, one can be granted access to speak to the University Bursar about a student's bill. But please note:

- ⇒ The caller cannot access information without stating their full name and four digit access code.
- ⇒ The Bursar cannot share academic information, with the caller.

# Alert Notification System

Dear UConn Stamford Campus Students,

The University of Connecticut Stamford campus is pleased to announce a new service available to students of the Stamford campus. You can now receive text messages sent to your cell phone for campus closings and weather-related delays and cancellations. This service is free of charge, but your cell phone plan's normal text message rates will apply. This new service is for the Stamford campus only and does not apply to any other regional campus or the Storrs campus.

The UConn Stamford Campus Text Messaging System is NOT a replacement for the University Alert Notification System\*. The University Alert Notification System is a comprehensive University wide system that will alert faculty, staff, students, and the community of any and all emergencies at the University of Connecticut. The new UConn Stamford Campus Text Messaging System is available to Stamford students for notification of campus closings and weather-related delays and cancellations only.

To subscribe to this free service all you have to do is text: STAMSTU to 88467 To unsubscribe from this service at any time and stop receiving student member texts, text: STOP STAMSTU to 88467
